WHY DO I NEED DRUG AND ALCOHOL REHAB?

Drug and <u>alcohol addictions</u> can take over your life. Even if it seems like you're hanging on at school or work, it still diminishes your quality of life. With over 23 million Americans addicted to substances, 75 percent don't receive necessary treatment according to the <u>National Institutes of Health (NIH)</u>. This means millions of people are living their lives suffering from addiction symptoms, but you don't have to.

Symptoms of addiction include:

Urges to use substances daily or several times a day

Intense feelings to use that take over your thoughts

Taking larger amounts than intended

Going through withdrawal when you stop taking drugs or alcohol

Spending money on drugs or alcohol that you can't afford

Engaging in risky behaviors, such as stealing and driving under the influence

If you want to not only break free from addiction but get your life back, you need drug and alcohol rehab. The many programs available help you through all stages of addiction.

SIGNS OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE

Drug and alcohol rehab in Meridian also helps beyond the regular symptoms of addiction. There are signs of drug use that challenge your health and behaviors. And programs at rehab provide support for



improving the situation.

Individuals abusing drugs and alcohol experience problems at school or in the workplace. Usually, there are many failures to show up, a drop in grades or performance, and a general disinterest in activities. The appearance will also change to very untidy due to a lack of interest in personal hygiene.

A person's behavior will change in an effort to abuse substances in secret or go out to find friends or dealers who encourage the habit. The relationship between old friends and family members become strained. It is common that money issues will come up, whether it's asking for more money or finding money or objects stolen.

Physical health issues first start to appear depending on their substance of choice. However, red eyes, weight gain or loss, and lack of motivation and energy are common.

If you or a loved one experiences the signs and symptoms of addiction, reach out for help today. Together we can end the cycle of addiction.Generally speaking, teens are unaware that substances can't fix what could be long-term problems. As they use illicit substances, their grades and relationships begin to suffer. However, the biggest concern is the effects that drugs have on their bodies.

Brain development is crucial for middle school-aged teens, and drugs affect the brain in several ways. For instance, <u>alcohol abuse</u> has a negative impact on the memory center in the brain. This effect makes it difficult to remember and recall information.

Drug use delays the development of

functions such as planning, completing tasks, meeting goals, and judgment. These delays make it harder for young teens to deal with the stressors and pressures of daily life. Drugs also confuse the brain's reward center, which in turn makes teens feel bad when they don't use them. This effect makes them want to use more, making the situation worse.

Parents who think that their teens have started to use drugs can get help through Zelus Recovery's early intervention program. They might notice uncharacteristic drops in grades or changes in friends. In some cases, these changes are normal for teens. However, parents should stay vigilant of other warning signs such as sneaking around and mood swings.

While <u>early intervention</u> prevents a lot of the strain of addiction, many don't reach out for help. This leads to many of the following problems in teens found by a <u>survey from</u> <u>the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIH):</u>

Addiction costs billions of dollars in health care, but the real problem is how many lives it costs from addiction-related deaths and overdoses. With so many teens abusing illicit substances and alcohol, <u>teen drug rehab</u> is as critical as ever.

HEALTH PROBLEMS CAUSED BY ADDICTION

Addiction causes many health problems in our loved ones including:

- Lung disease

Although many who have a substance use disorder began by selfmedicating with drugs or alcohol, substance abuse can lead to a mental health disorder. In fact, about half of those suffering from a substance use disorder will experience a mental health disorder and vice versa.
