In 2018, about 695,000 people ages 12-17 misused prescription pain relievers.




Over 561,000 people ages 12-17 were addicted to stimulants in 2018.

WHAT THERAPY OPTIONS DOES AN ADDICTION TREATMENT CENTER IN BOISE OFFER?

When you get treatment at an addiction treatment center in Boise, you're going to spend a significant amount of time in therapy. Therapy helps you figure out why you turned to alcohol in the first place. It also is a vital part of the healing process. At Zelus Recovery, we offer a variety of therapies, including:

Cognitive-behavioral therapy: During this therapy, you will work with a counselor to understand the patterns of thoughts and behaviors. Once you have identified negative patterns, you can create coping mechanisms to build new healthy ones.

Dialectical behavior therapy: During this off-shoot of cognitive-behavioral therapy, you will work alone or in a group to recognize how substance abuse has harmed you. Moreover, you will learn new communication skills to rebuild broken relationships.
